**RESOLUTION
DECLARING THE ENTIRE PROVINCE OF
MARINDUQUE UNDER A STATE OF CALAMITY DUE
TO TYPHOON NINA**

WHEREAS, in December 26, 2016, the entire province of Marinduque was placed under Severe Weather Storm Signal No. 4 by the PAGASA and was forecast to be within the track of Typhoon NINA;

WHEREAS, Marinduque felt the intense fury and impact wrought by Typhoon Nina leaving the entire province with widespread devastation in all areas, leaving thousands of families totally homeless and displaced and an estimated billions worth of properties extensively damaged;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction Management Council (PDRRMC), in its Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis had reported a PARTIAL ESTIMATED damages in the entire province as of December 27, 2016, as follows:

<i>Estimated No. of Affected Families</i>	-	<i>52,000 families</i>
<i>Estimated Damage to Agriculture</i>	-	<i>P1,530,275,775.00</i>
<i>Estimated Damage to Infrastructure</i>	-	<i>P124,110,000.00</i>

WHEREAS, due to such extreme and extensive damages suffered by the province, the PDRRMC had recommended for the provincial declaration of state of calamity;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan likewise felt the need for the said declaration to effectively restore and rehabilitated the living conditions and capacities of the affected families, livelihood, infrastructure and other service facilities of the province;

WHEREFORE, premises considered and on motion unanimously seconded, it was:

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, TO DECLARE THE ENTIRE OF PROVINCE OF MARINDUQUE UNDER A STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO TYPHOON NINA.

RESOLVED, finally, that copies of this resolution be furnished all offices and agencies concerned for their information and appropriate action.
